

## Copenhagen Testicular Cancer Workshops

These Workshops were initiated in 1980 by Professor Niels E. Skakkebæk to discuss the importance of carcinoma in situ testis (now known as germ cell neoplasia in situ, GCNIS) and have since grown to the only meeting worldwide devoted to testicular cancer. The Workshops have always been held at Rigshospitalet and organized by the staff of the Department of Growth & Reproduction, a unique research and patient care unit active within two overlapping fields of pediatric endocrinology and andrology. A broad spectrum of topics pertinent to the pathogenesis, epidemiology, genetics, molecular biology, and management of testicular cancer were discussed at the Workshops.

The **9<sup>th</sup> Copenhagen Workshop on Testicular Germ Cell Cancer** was held on 24 - 26 October 2018. The program of the Workshop can be found here:

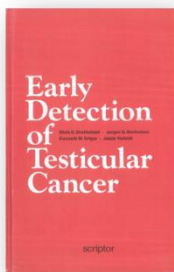

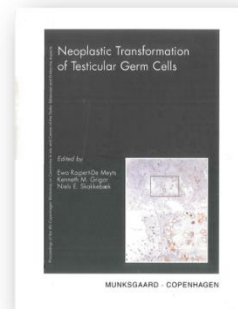
1<sup>st</sup> 1980 (IJA 1981)



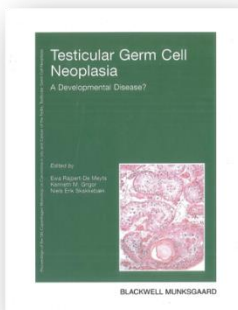
2<sup>nd</sup> 1986 (IJA 1987)

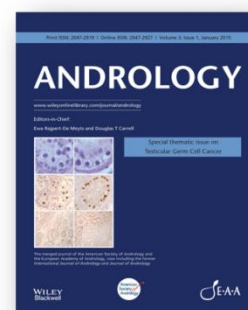
